

Creeks.

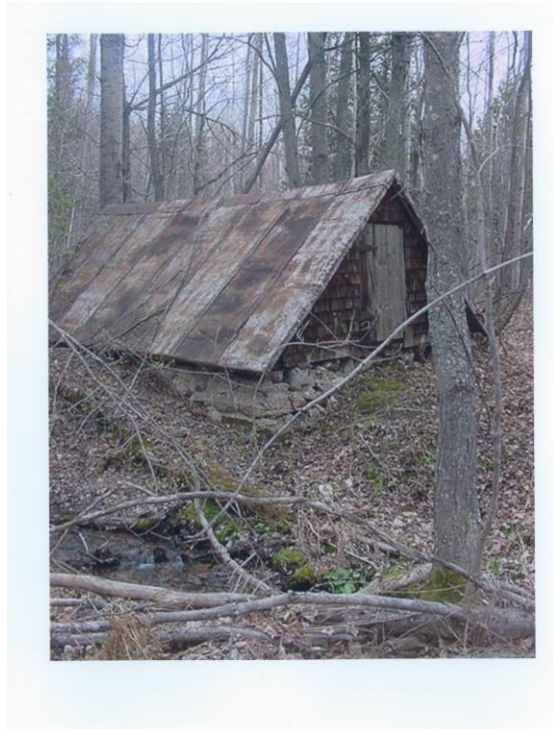
Mike Schira, Son in law to Dorothy and Richard Chandler shares:

All of those creeks/streams crossing the canal road start from springs that form (well most all, not Schlotz Creek) at the base of the higher ridgeline running parallel to the road.

There used to be an artesian well on the canal next to Henry Garnell's waterfront house....probably still there on son's (Deric) property now. (There are artesians as well along the lakeshore on Osma Plat resident's property.)

Schlotz Creek starts in Obenhoff Lake according to Ted Ruohonen. The lake was good for fishing.

The water supply for Oscar Eliassen's farm and later the Frank Eilola store came from an artesian well on Lahнала property.. Now Kempke property.
