

Mediator. September 19, 1898

10 miles NE of station. While on their way to the Colorado, surfmen found this vessel ashore 1 mile west of the mouth of Gratiot River, but as all hands were ashore, keeper decided to go on to the Colorado. On the 26th, however, station crew went to the Mediator in tow of a tug, and after they had removed part of her deck load of lumber, the tug was able to pull her afloat. Towed her to Houghton, but she was abandoned there and became a total loss. USLSS Annual Report 1899.
