

Montana. September 26, 1895.

Struck and stranded, swinging across channel at entrance to canal. Station crew ran lines from her to piers and straightened her in channel. Telephoned for tug at master's request, which upon arrival towed steamer inside, where she filled and sank. On the 29th and 30th surfmen assisted in shifting deck load of flour and putting steni pump on board. Cleared her of water and tug took her to a port for discharging cargo. USLSS
