

Stanton Township School Facts obtained from resources at MTU Archives:

- In 1865 tuition averaged 44 cents per student.
- 1957 brought student enrollment decline. The number of children per woman was about 3.8, currently (1977) is 1.8 children per woman. In Stanton enrollment in 1975 was 203, in 1976 was 185.
- Spring of 1970 Board members Richard Chandler, Pres; Diana Johnson, Sect'y; Mel Anderson, Treas.; Emil Niemi, Niilo Maki proposed to consolidate Adams Chassell Portage and Stanton. It failed with voters.
- In 1998 Stanton School board members looked into consolidating South Stanton Heikkinen School with Winona School. It was considered not feasible. Board members then were Mike Benda, Pres; Ray Sharp, VP; Barb Koski, Secretary; Rebecca Hoekstra, Treas.; and Jack Dunstan. Heikkinen School built in 1919 closes at end of school year 1999.
- EB Holman Elementary School had addition (Wisti wing) put on for middle schoolers in 1989. First students used the new facility in January of 1990.
